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Just Released: Berlin Events 2009/2010

The new brochure "Berlin Events 2009/2010", with several special pages devoted to commemorations of the twentieth anniversary of the fall of the Berlin Wall, provides detailed information about a great many upcoming activities. These include a large, fan-shaped exhibition at the Alexanderplatz, numerous events at venues illustrating recent changes in the city, an open-air theater spectacle with sixteen meter (fifty-three foot) tall marionettes, and a big ceremony on November 9, 2009.

The new edition of the bilingual "Berlin Events" brochure is published in a handy pocket-sized format. This new guide, clearly organized with a modern design, provides a long-term overview of events in the fields of entertainment, theater, classical music, pop, rock, jazz, and sports, as well as the entire Berlin opera and ballet program for the 2009-10 season. The most important tradeshows and a selection of major Christmas markets are also summarized in colored text boxes.

A well-illustrated extra section at the end of the brochure has short passages introducing outstanding special and long-running exhibitions in Berlin through the end of 2010. The 220,000 copies of the new "Berlin Events" will be used at national and international tourism tradeshows, sold in the BERLIN infostores, and laid out for guests in approximately 350 Berlin hotels.
