A professional guide takes you on a 60-minute tour through the stadium, to areas that are otherwise closed to the public. Visit the venue of the 2006 FIFA World Cup™, the I2th IAAF World Championships in Athletics Berlin 2009 and of the 6th FIFA Women's World Cup 2011™, the VIP areas, changing rooms and the underground warm-up training hall.

Enjoy the impressive perspective of this state of the art stadium, standing at the edge on the blue running track while your guide illustrates the history and architecture of the Olympiastadion Berlin.



For security reasons and/or during event preparations certain areas (e.g. the players' changing rooms) or even the whole stadium may be closed at short notice and is therefore not open for viewing.

Cash and credit card payments are accepted at the ticket office. We regret that due to the architectural conditions the guided tours are only partially suitable for wheelchair users and people with walking difficulties.
